

# SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS AND RISK ASSESSMENT

---

**When using or installing the tobacco cabinet, IT IS MANDATORY** to follow basic safety rules at all times in order to **avoid the risk of injury**.

- 1. Read and understand the entire manual and observe all warnings before you start.**
2. The cabinets are to be used indoor only. Do not use the cabinets outdoors.
3. Specific Use: This cabinet is exclusively intended for storing and displaying tobacco products.  
Do not use for other purposes.
4. Flammable Materials: Product made of chipboards and painted metal. Avoid exposure to open flames or intense heat sources.
5. UV Protection: Do not place in direct sunlight. Prolonged exposure may cause material discoloration and deformation.
6. Avoid Liquid Contact: Do not expose the product to water, excessive moisture, or other liquids.  
Risk of short circuit and structural damage.
7. Do not use liquid or aerosol cleaning agents. Clean using damp or dry material only.
8. Ventilation: Ensure adequate ventilation around the cabinet to prevent overheating of electrical systems.
9. In order to avoid the risk of injury, do not disassemble this unit and do not replace any of its parts.  
Opening the unit and removing its parts may make it less durable.
10. Place the cabinet on a stable, flat surface. Handle with care to avoid damage.
11. Secure the unit as per anchoring instructions. Falling units can cause serious damage and/or personal harm.
12. Sliding Doors: Handle sliding doors with care. Do not block sliding paths and avoid finger entrapment.
13. Always check the unit and its installation if any of the following occurs:
  - The cabinet does not work properly although all instructions have been followed
  - The unit is unstable or its usual working position has been changed.
  - The unit has fallen down or is physically damaged.
14. Regular Maintenance: Regularly check the cabinets's condition and electrical operation.  
In case of malfunction disconnect power and contact an authorized service center.
15. Electrical Components: This product contains electrical installations. Only qualified personnel should handle electrical components.
16. If the external flexible cable or cord is damaged, it shall be exclusively replaced by the manufacturer or his service agent or qualified person in order to avoid hazard.
17. The light source shall only be replaced by the manufacturer or his service agent or qualified person.
18. The DC power supply must be replaced by the manufacturer, his service agent, or a qualified person.
19. Failure to install this cabinet in accordance with its installation instructions (which require complete and correct installation of each section), releases the manufacturer from any liability. Responsibility lies with the end recipient and installer, who are accountable for any bodily harm or material damage to themselves, employees, colleagues, family members (including minors or persons with disabilities), customers, and their companions.
20. The installer undertakes to follow the safety instructions and those complementary ones that are mandatory in the country where the installation takes place.
